Expansion of milk consumption in North Africa through free distribution program was agreed to on assumption manifest figures correct. (To Agwar Washington info to USFOR London from Freedom signed Eisenhower cite FHAEB Short and Cutler 9259, 26th Mar too nil). Action Agwar Combined Boards information USFOR British Chiefs of Staff signed Eisenhower cite FHAEB Short and Cutler BOC 268. Lend lease 121. However actual arrivals UG 3 and 4 were 3700 tons evaporated as compared to 6200 tons shown on manifests and signed bills of lading. 500 tons evaporated if possible sweetened on UG 7 and same UG 7 1/2 are required to build up 1 months reserve and insure against curtailment present program. Powdered if obtainable should be substituted for half this requirement at ratio 1 powdered to 3 evaporated. All shipments within existing tonnage allotments and consigned inside 1/3 Oran 2/3 Algiers.

Para 2. Current monthly requirements follow stated in terms of evaporated. Algeria. Government ration 310 tons. Free distribution 705 tons. Tunis Government ration 95 tons. Free distribution. 300 tons. Total monthly requirements 1805 tons. *
3,000 tons leaving approximately 1200 tons. This plus requested arrival 1,000 tons will provide stock 2200 tons or slightly more than one months supply.

Para 5. Pending arrival requested shipments endeavouring to increase Algeria Government ration stocks by diversions from Algeria free distribution and Morocco Government supplies. If requested ship-

Para 6. Recommend shipment of sweetened instead of unsweetened if obtainable. If unobtainable recommend shipment in half pound cans if practicable for use in government ration which is mainly to infants under 18 months since unsweetened keeps only 1 day without refrigeration in this climate and infants consume average of less than 3/5 pound per day. Corrections. 1st. After Tunis Government ration 95 tons. And before free distribution. Insert Tunis stockpile 300 tons. Morocco. 2. Last indicator between shipment in half insert unsweetened to read thus shipment unsweetened is half.
